

## To get started with building or starting up...

- USDA REDLG program (zero interest loan of up to \$2 Million\* for 10 years) your electric or telecom cooperative applies on your behalf; we will walk you through this process and put the application together for you
  - This amount may fluctuate depending on USDA's budget and other factors
- Blue Cross Blue Shield Caring Foundation (Grant) Caring Foundation | BCBSND
- RDFC's revolving loan fund; low interest, flexible, easy to apply RDFC Rural Development Finance Corporation | North Dakota Association of Rural Electric Cooperatives (ndarec.com)
- North Dakota Development Fund, Inc (Child Care Loan Program Maximum of \$100,000 per location or based on availability of fund, interest 2.5% - Fixed, term 1-10 years, dependent upon project.) - Child Care Loan Program (nd.gov)
- Formation of employer-assisted childcare cooperatives (formed as a 501c3) where the
  employers provide financial support for the startup of a childcare and are able to take a tax
  deduction for their contribution.
